

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But even these recourses depend on historical information, except for in limited, often artificial cases in which experiments can be devised to determine how people act. In a society that quite correctly expects education to serve useful purposes, the functions of history can seem more difficult to define than those of engineering or medicine.

Historians do not perform heart transplants, improve highway design, or arrest criminals.. Consequently, history must serve, however imperfectly, as our laboratory, and data from the past must serve as our most vital evidence in the unavoidable quest to figure out why our complex species behaves as it does in societal settings.. History is in fact very useful, actually indispensable, but the products of historical study are less tangible, sometimes less immediate, than those that stem from some other disciplines.. There are many ways to discuss the real functions of the subject—as there are many different historical talents and many different paths to historical meaning.. But audiences less spontaneously drawn to the subject and more doubtful about why to bother need to know what the purpose is.

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In the past history has been justified for reasons we would no longer accept For instance, one of the reasons history holds its place in current education is because earlier leaders believed that a knowledge of certain historical facts helped distinguish the educated from the uneducated; the person who could reel off the date of the Norman conquest of England (1066) or the name of the person who came up with the theory of evolution at about the same time that Darwin did (Wallace) was deemed superior-a better candidate for law school or even a business promotion. An exclusive reliance on current data would needlessly handicap our efforts How can we evaluate war if the nation is at peace-unless we use historical materials? How can we understand genius, the influence of technological innovation, or the role that beliefs play in shaping family life, if we don't use what we know about experiences in the past?
